- All students follow instructions the first time in lessons so that they can learn and go on to pursue careers that they desire

The vast majority of our students behave well.


As part of this procedure, we are introducing additional rewards for students that meet our expectations. Some of these rewards include emails at the end of the week to the parents of all students who met our expectations, certificates at the end of the month for good behaviour (no behaviour points gained), lunch with the headteacher for students with no behaviour points and a chance for 3 students to win a £10 voucher at the end of every half term.
