

## Year 7 Catch up funding 2018-2019

This year we have received £18,000 to enable Year 7 Catch Up.

In Year 7 we have 148 students on roll. There are currently 44 students in Maths and 50 students in English who are below the threshold to be classified as secondary school ready. See below for further breakdown.

### Summary of provision

#### Maths

The students with the lowest Maths score have small class support, this allows the bottom set in Maths to have smaller numbers to provide more personalised support.

Of the 25 students with a Maths score of 94 or less, 24 are making expected progress with one student already exceeding end of year targets.

#### English

**Literacy Small Group** - 16 students with the lowest Reading scores given small group support (4 groups with a 1:4 ratio).

As of February 2019 all students were making at least expected progress in English due to the support given, 9 students were making more than expected progress.

From February 2019 the following strategies will also be implemented:

**Reading Circle** group of 12 students of a reading age below 10 will meet in two groups.  
**Read Write Inc** - 7 students with a reading age below 10 will receive additional weekly support.

**EAL literacy support** - 4 students with low reading ages to receive additional weekly support.

**Writing Support** - students with a low reading age also given support to develop their writing.
